

**Student Exchange Support Program supported by JASSO 2019
(Scholarship for Short-term Study in Japan)**

International Center for Biotechnology (ICBiotech) operates “Bioindustry & Biodiversity” and “ASEAN Biotechnology School” programs under the auspices of JASSO. The former is a lab-study-program conducted in cooperation with the consortium consists of Thai top 4 universities (Mahidol U., Chulalongkorn U., Kasetsart U. and KMUTT). The latter was started last year to accept students from other ASEAN countries. These programs, organized for master and doctoral students from Thailand and other ASEAN countries studying “Bioindustry and Biodiversity” related fields, aim at enhancing students’ research ability in biotechnology, making them understand current condition and problems in the application of researches to bioindustry, as well as improving their mutual understanding through discussion on biodiversity.

This year, a total of 24 students, 18 for “Bioindustry & Biodiversity” program and 6 for “ASEAN Biotechnology School” program, joined from November 5, 2019 to December 10, 2019, as follows:
