Student Exchange Program (SSSV Program) supported by Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) FY2025 Japan-ASEAN Training Program for Future Leaders in Bio-Manufacturing

The SSSV Program is an international student exchange program conducted in collaboration with a Thai academic consortium. This consortium comprises four of Thailand's leading universities: Mahidol University, Chulalongkorn University, Kasetsart University, and King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi (KMUTT). The program also involves participation from prominent universities in other ASEAN countries, including Vietnam, the Philippines, and Indonesia.

The SSSV Program is financially supported by the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) through its Student Exchange Support Program. In the current fiscal year, fourteen graduate students were invited to The University of Osaka, where they studied for 42 days (see next page). At the same time, sixteen The University of Osaka students participated in a study program in Thailand.

In this program, ICBiotech and other biotechnology-related laboratories at The University of Osaka provided advanced research and educational opportunities to the invited students. The program covered a wide range of topics, including biodiversity, intellectual property, and the practical applications of biotechnology, aiming to promote sustainable industries and societies among the participants.
